1. Covid-19 daily updates. Each day there is an update from the Provincial Operation Centre outlining the event in the Province. There is also an update twice per week from Garry Dzoiba (Field Officer South Region Alberta Emergency Management Agency). Also I am in touch with Ross from Ridge Regional Public Safety Services, as needed. Jamie from the County who is our Regional Director of Disaster Services along with the CAO's from our neighboring communities are also in contact as needed.

I have been in contact with the administration team of the new COVID-19 check point that AHS has set up when coming north through the Port. I have heard and looked into a couple complaints from locals, but none feel it necessary to make an official complaint, so none was made.

- 2. Water break in Montana. I attended a meeting with MLA Hunter, The County of Warner, and the Town of Milk River. I have also been in contact with Alberta Environment and Parks. To date there has been no announcement of a repair, or a temporary diversion. There is another meeting on June 26 that Mayor Willett and Dep. Mayor MacCumber will attend as well. MP Motz and MLA Hunter will both be in attendance. Topics will include the Water issue, Police Funding and HALO
- 3. Paving and street sweeping is done. Both went well.
- 4. We will continue to do the year end statements via scan and email. The accountant's office is not yet open and they are working from home. It's a bit time consuming but we will get it done. Municipal Affairs moved the deadline for the statements from May 1 to October 1, in light of the pandemic.
- 5. HALO Auction. I am an admin on the Border Communities Auction for HALO. Mostly doing what needs done on my own time. We're hoping to make a good sized donation. The auction ends on Saturday June 13, at 10 am.
